The scientific summer event for aspiring European Endocrinologists

The International ESE Summer School on Endocrinology has a long standing tradition as an interactive teaching and meeting event for young and aspiring researchers in academia, clinics, public domain research institutes and industry. As an exception in 2017 the meeting venue had to be relocated to the small island Schwanenwerder located in the Wannsee, one of the major lakes of Berlin, Germany, because the traditional location of this summer school near Bregenz, Austria, the Monastery Mehrerau is undergoing a major reconstruction during the summer months of 2017.

The 2017 location has direct lake access for swimming, courts for joint sport activities, and opportunities for leisure time. The ESE Summer School with its unique atmosphere will certainly entice the international participants to hormone-related brain-storming, scientific discussions, networking, and career shaping accompanied by physical activities and cultural exposure.

Berlin, one of the most vibrant European Capitals is easy to reach from everywhere and offers attractions to everyone planning to spend additional time before or after the summer school enjoying this place.

The meeting location, the Evangelische Bildungsstätte auf Schwanenwerder, can house up to 62 guests, participation will be confirmed on first come - first served basis. An overflow hotel has been reserved in walking distance.

Travel information

By car:

A115 (AVUS), exit Spanische Allee, Wannseebadweg, Inselstraße 27-28, 14129 Berlin

By air:

Arriving at Airport Tegel:

- Take the express bus X9 (direction S+U Zoologischer Garten) from the airport to S+U Zoologischer Garten
- Change to S7 (direction S Potsdam Hbf) to S Nikolassee
- From station Nikolassee, a shuttle bus will take you to the meeting venue

Arrival at Airport Schönefeld

- Take the express bus X7 (direction U Rudow) from the airport to U Rudow
- Change to U7 (direction S+U Rathaus Spandau to S+U Yorkstraße)
- Change to S1 (direction S Wannsee to S Nikolassee)
- From station S Nikolassee, a shuttle bus will take you to the meeting venue

By train:**Arrival at Berlin Hauptbahnhof:**

- Take the S7 (direction S Potsdam Hbf) to S Nikolassee
- From station Nikolassee, a shuttle bus will take you to the meeting venue
